Role	Walking Bus Volunteer – Bagatelle Schools
Location	Liberation Square to Victoria College Preparatory (VCP), Jersey College Preparatory (JCP), Beaulieu Primary and De La Salle Junior School
Responsible to	Jersey Sport – Active Travel Team
Level of commitment	We ask that volunteers commit to supporting one Wednesday morning per week from approximately 7:40-8:40am during school term time only.
The walking bus	<p>A walking bus is an active form of student transport for school children who are chaperoned by adult volunteers. The scheme is initially for Key Stage 2 pupils (Y3+) from VCP, JCP, Beaulieu and De La Salle. The walking bus will start at Liberation Square and then walk a fully risk-assessed route calling first to VCP and then split, going on to Beaulieu, JCP & De La Salle.</p> <p>The bus will operate to the correct adult to pupil ratios recommended by the attending schools.</p>
Walking bus volunteer duties	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Working with other volunteers to ensure the health and safety of participants is adhered to - Meet and greet pupils - Chaperone students - Provide information - Volunteers will receive full training before they start - Volunteers will be provided with a volunteer pack upon training - Report any concerns or worries to the appropriate person
Skills required for the role	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Enthusiasm - Approachability and friendliness - Great interpersonal and communication skills - Patience and an inclusive approach to engagement - Reliability and punctuality - An enhanced DBS check will be carried out by Jersey Sport prior to training
