

***This code of conduct outlines the responsibilities and standards of conduct expected by walking bus attendees when walking on the Bagatelle Schools walking bus. Please return this to your schools office prior to attending.***

***This code of conduct is designed to:***

- Provide a benchmark for good conduct among walking bus attendees.
- Set out standards and expectations for how walking bus attendees should interact with others.
- Ensure everyone knows what is required of them when they decide to join the walking bus.

---

***The code of conduct is structured around two key themes:***

- Rights of children on the walking bus.
- Personal standards (the behaviour that can be expected of walking bus attendees).

---

***Rights***

***Attendees must respect and champion the rights of every individual to participate in the walking bus. They should:***

- Help create a friendly environment where everyone is welcome on the walking bus.
- Maintain an environment that is free of bullying.
- Always treat all individuals with respect.
- Communicate with participants with respect and care.
- Respect others (public, attendees and volunteers).

---

***Personal standards***

***Walking bus attendees should demonstrate appropriate behaviour and conduct at all times. Walking bus attendees should:***

- Show respect, be fair, considerate, and honest to other attendees on the bus.
- Endeavour to always support others on the walking bus.
- Display high standards of language, manner, punctuality, and preparation.
- Be a positive role model for other participants, especially those younger than themselves.
- Always listen to the adults in charge.
