# We would like to remind all parents and guardians of the importance of closely supervising your children on school premises at the end of the school day.

Our site manager recently reported an incident where a group of young children were seen climbing on a high wall near the bus shelter. While their parents were present, the children continued to climb despite being asked to come down for their own safety. The same group was later seen on another wall, with their parents engaged in conversation nearby.

Please be aware that it is the responsibility of parents and guardians to supervise their children while on school grounds at the end of the day, especially when school staff are not directly responsible for their care. It is vital that children refrain from climbing on walls or other areas as this poses a serious safety risk.

Additionally, it is our policy that children do not use the climbing / play equipment after school has finished.

We ask for your cooperation in ensuring the safety of all children by keeping a close eye on them and preventing any unsafe behaviour.


