More improvements are planned between St Saviour's Primary School and VCP School. These will be delivered in another phase.



We learnt all about the weapons that were used and changed over time, and that it was very important for the castle to have its own supply of water and food, just in case we were invaded by our French neighbours!

We had a go at using some of the shields, armour and helmets that would have been worn during the castle's long history (funnily enough we were not allowed to use the swords), and peered over the battlements to see the amazing view over the bay.

Later in the week we wrote recounts of our trip and our highlights of the day, and are looking forward to learning even more this term about castles!
