Thank you to everyone who took the time to complete our annual survey. Your feedback, alongside that of our students and staff, plays a vital role in helping us reflect on our practices and continually improve the experience and provision we offer here at College..

At JCG, we are committed to creating the very best environment: one that inspires critical thinking, resilience, and a love of learning. Developing the ability to navigate uncertainty, to find creative solutions and possessing confidence in ourselves, is key to this.

Following feedback over the last two years, we have worked hard to improve how we celebrate the success of all of our students both academically and pastorally, in and beyond the College. Other priorities have included the following: how we give feedback to students to ensure their learning moves forward; developing oracy by building speaking and listening skills into our curriculum; our contribution to our community; and our commitment to students' understanding of environmental issues.

We are, therefore, thrilled that 95% of respondents agree or strongly agree that, here at JCG, we reward good behaviour and students' academic and co-curricular achievement, in addition to 95% of parents stating that they would recommend JCG to others.

We have continued to improve the various ways that we offer feedback to our students so that they develop a

deep understanding of how learning works. Feedback is not only in traditional, formal marking but also through verbal, whole class and peer feedback. Teachers have been supporting students to self-assess and take action to secure deeper learning for themselves. We have worked hard to provide students with sufficient time in lessons to reflect upon their work and the feedback that is given, which allows them to move forwards. Our staff regularly share good practice in our weekly faculty meetings and as part of our weekly learning tip. However, we know that reflective practice is the best way for teachers to improve outcomes for students, and this will remain a focus for the coming year.

96% of parents agree or strongly agree that the College offers opportunities for students to develop their listening and speaking skills. Developing oracy skills remains a College priority and we continue to build speaking and listening into the curriculum, our learning and teaching, and the wider life of the College. Our vision for oracy is that all students should be taught to use their voice to reason, negotiate, present and explore ideas as an integral part of their learning and, in doing so, become eloquent.



Our students are our best ambassadors, and they are at the heart of all we do. Equally, we want them to go out into the world and build a better society. We encourage our students, through JCG Serves, our House system and in individual subjects, to give back to their community both in our College, our island and beyond. Therefore, it is fantastic to see that 97% of respondents agree or strongly agree that JCG contributes to the Jersey community.

This year, our students initiated and helped to organise Jersey's first Youth Climate Summit, which took place in November 2024 at the Radisson Hotel. As a result of this, six

students and two staff are now Certified Carbon Literate. We are so proud of our Eco Captains who organised this event, and they went on to win the Best Student Led Initiative award. Our work to reduce our carbon footprint and increase student awareness remains a priority for the coming year, and, from September, we will add carbon footprint information to all College-made food items on sale in both the Dome and Hector's.

“ The range of opportunities on offer to the students.

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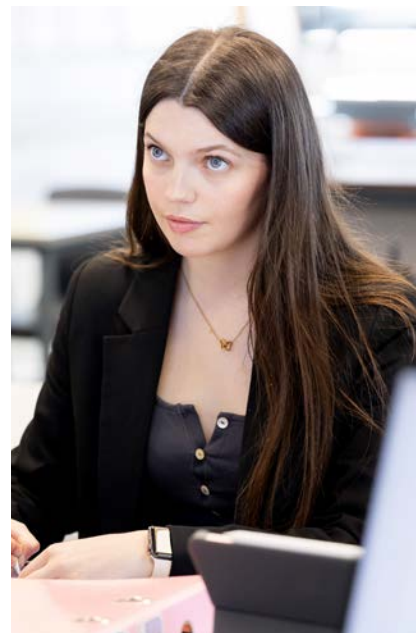
