Thank you to everyone who took the time to complete this year's annual survey. Your feedback, alongside that of our students and staff, is invaluable in helping us reflect on our practice and continually enhance the experience we provide at JCG.

At the College, we remain committed to creating an environment where every student can thrive academically, socially and personally. We strive to nurture confident, articulate and resilient young women who are equipped to think critically, embrace challenge and contribute positively to the world around them.

Over the past year, we have continued to focus on key priorities informed by your views, including strengthening feedback to support student progress, embedding oracy across the curriculum and celebrating a broader range of student achievement.

We are thrilled that 96% of respondents agree or strongly agree that JCG develops a strong understanding and sense of leadership. The She Leads programme now moves into its third year and offers a range of opportunities for students to lead in a variety of ways including making podcasts, hosting the first Unleashed Voices event, participating in Speak 4 Her (our EVAWG action group) and hosting inter-school MUN conferences. In the summer term, we held

our first Voices of Experience event for Year 10 and 12 which was a huge success, and we remain very grateful to our alumni and parents who contributed to that. A particular highlight came in the form of TEDx JCG, the island's first TEDx Youth event which was organised and delivered by JCG students. The depth of thought, courage, and communication skills they demonstrated at such a young age was genuinely inspiring and we look forward to building on the success of this event next year.

Feedback last year suggested there was work for us to do to ensure that our students challenge themselves, both in their lessons and through our extracurricular programme. We have encouraged students to challenge their thinking and bravely enter competitions such as Science Olympiads, UK Maths Challenges, the GCHQ National Language Competition, high level sports fixtures and Rotary Young Chef competitions to name just a few. We are pleased, therefore, that 94% of respondents agree or strongly agree that students are supported to pursue challenging experiences in a proudly all-girls environment that is both



safe and nurturing.

We are proud of the progress made, particularly through initiatives such as our oracy work with Voice 21 and the continued evolution of our Personal Development programme, focused on three strands: She Leads, She Serves, She Grows. We believe that education extends far beyond academic success and that every girl should leave the College not only intellectually accomplished, but also confident, compassionate, resilient, and ready to contribute meaningfully to the world around her. The Personal Development provision intentionally creates opportunities for students to develop character, self-awareness, leadership, and social responsibility at every

stage of their journey.

It is encouraging to see that 95% of respondents agree or strongly agree that JCG contributes to the Jersey community. Service remains at the heart of what it means to be a JCG student and is a defining feature of our House system. Each House supports a local charity, raising funds while also, as of this year, giving generously of their time through volunteering and service opportunities. In this way, students develop a lifelong commitment to contributing positively to their community and making a meaningful difference to the lives of others.

These outcomes reflect the dedication of our staff, the enthusiasm of our students, and the strength of our partnership with parents.

“The incredible women that come out into the world from it. Extremely well educated, confident and well rounded.



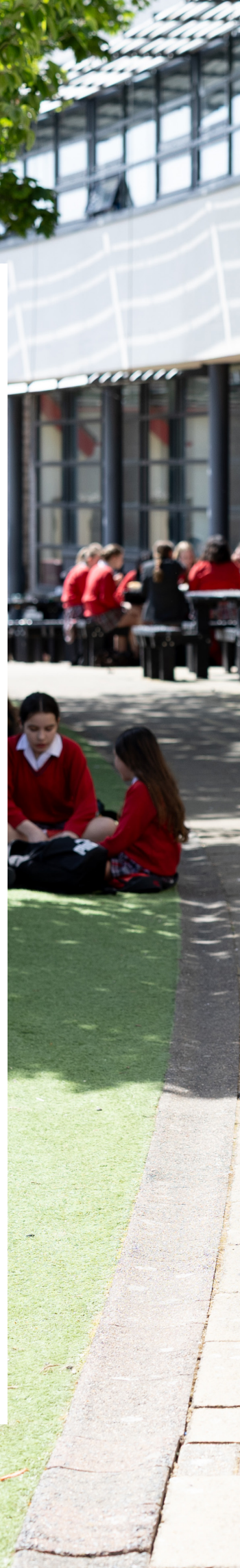
Next steps for 2026/2027
